Torchiere TLC

This week we have been continuing the restoration of a beautiful pair of torchieres. The legs had unfortunately split, which meant taking them completely apart to carry out the repairs properly.

The old dowels were carefully drilled out, all the joints cleaned up, and everything was re-glued and re-dowelled to ensure a strong and lasting repair. Damaged decorative woodwork was also replaced, with careful colour matching to blend seamlessly with the original pieces. The final stage has been recolouring the repaired areas to make the restoration as discreet as possible.
